RICHFIELD — Proof that bills which come before the Utah Legislature originate in unlikely places came to light after the passage of a measure to adopt the elk as Utah's official animal and the rainbow trout as the state fish.

Sen. Kendrick Harward, R-Richfield, introduced the bill in the Senate on the opening day, while Rep. Dewain Washburn, D-Morroe, introduced the bill in the House. The idea for the elk and rainbow trout came from a fourth grade class in Ashman Elementary School in Richfield, taught by Jerald Oldroyd. For the past four
